Private senior-care search

Compare options without turning one inquiry into a call cascade.

Use this before entering a phone number into a senior-care search, matching, or referral form. It is educational and does not recommend a provider.

1 Search directly.

Use each provider's official website, a government directory, or a professional you already trust.

2 Make the shortlist first.

Record names, official URLs, care type, price range, and questions before contacting anyone.

3 Read the sharing language.

Look for partners, network providers, advisors, matching services, and consent-withdrawal terms.

4 Keep one clean trail.

If practical, use a dedicated email or secondary number and log the date and method of each contact.

Record this before contacting a provider

- Provider / facility
- Official URL + phone
- Date + method
- Who receives my info?
- How do I withdraw consent?

If calls already started

One company? Build one free request. Several callers or providers? Open a private workspace with separate drafts, status, reminders, and export - \$19 once.
